

Visitor Parking Options











Year round, a vehicle must display a valid permit to park on campus excluding weekends, when the university is closed, or designated by special signage.

Weekdays (Monday - Thursday 7:30 am to 10 pm and Friday 7:30 am to 4:30 pm) a permit is required in all lots or as posted. Resident lots are restricted 24 hours.




Weekdays (after 4:30 p.m.) commuter and most employee lots are open to all permits unless otherwise posted.

Weekends (Friday 4:30 p.m. - Sunday) a permit is not required in commuter and most employee lots unless otherwise posted.

- 15** 15 minute parking no permit required stalls are located throughout campus.
